

NHS Safety Thermometer: Data Terms of Use

Management Purposes

The data is made available to NHS organisations for ‘management purposes’ on the understanding that it is used appropriately, as follows:

- It must not be used to make public statements or pronouncements, or cause, or allow it to appear in public either directly or indirectly
- It must not be used to try to influence or affect the timing or content of other official publications
- It may however be used by NHS colleagues as management metrics or indicators to help analyse or identify actions for improvement, and to monitor related improvement activities

Accidental or wrongful release of data must be reported to the Health and Social Care Information Centre promptly, and may need to be reported to the National Statistician; contact enquiries@hscic.gov.uk for further advice, if in doubt.

Small numbers

Information about an individual that is not already public must not be identifiable, or able to be deduced from Health and Social Care Information Centre statistics. Even if you obtain Information Centre permission to reproduce material, you must not release any figures in public that could allow this.

Any number, rate or percentage derived from Health and Social Care Information Centre statistics must be suppressed if there is a risk of identification. Figures that may identify individuals when subtracted from totals, sub totals or other published figures must also be suppressed.

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Re-use of data

If you wish to re-use any data from any purpose other than 'management' you must ask us for specific permission and it is our decision whether to allow such re-use.

Freedom of Information Act 2000

If you receive a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 which would include data obtained from Safety Thermometer, you must advise us of the request and proposed response, allowing us sufficient time to provide you with our view on disclosure.
