The National Casemix Office provides the tools to convert patient notes into pound notes by designing and developing Healthcare Resources Groups (HRGs) - the building blocks of healthcare activities. Used to cost and reimburse those who provide NHS care, such as hospitals across England, 2013 saw Casemix deliver the latest design - HRG4+ - which has gained international acknowledgment for its innovative approach.
