### Introduction

This document provides a high-level summary of the requested changes currently in development or under consideration for a future version of the Improving Access To Psychological Therapies (IAPT) Data Set.

The IAPT Data Set Information Standard will be formally maintained by NHS Digital's Community and Mental Health Team (CMHT) to ensure that the data set remains fit for purpose. Amendments may be required in response to any changes in clinical practice or coding, changes to policy requirements, changes to the NHS Data Model and Dictionary, and requests for corrections by care providers or system suppliers.
